

Cookie Policy

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile device by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

Please be aware that restricting or blocking cookies may impact on the functionality of our website and it may not work properly.

Controlling Cookies

Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings. To find out more about cookies, including how to see what cookies have been set and how to manage and delete them, visit www.allaboutcookies.org.

You may limit site operation or functions if you limit cookies.

How do we use cookies on our website?

We make use of cookies to help manage the site and your visitor experience. The cookies we use are to manage logins.

What are the reasons for using different types of cookies?

Necessary cookies - These are cookies which we need for the website to work properly. They cover areas such as ensuring the website functions, allowing you to log into your account(s) and helping us monitor and maintain security of the website.

Information storage and access – the cookies and the information they contain are only stored while the session is active (known as a Session Cookie) and they hold information related to your session with us.

How to manage necessary cookies

For cookies which we have listed as being required we do not have a current mechanism that would allow you to opt out in an automated fashion.

These cookies are required to make the sites work in the correct fashion or offer enhanced security.

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.
